### **MINUTES:**

The Minutes of the Parish Meeting held on Monday 17<sup>th</sup> April 2007, copies having been circulated were signed as a true record.

### **CHAIRMAN'S REPORT:**

The Chairman gave details of expenditure for the year April 2007 to March 2008.

### **MATTERS RAISED:**

- (a) Land adjacent to River Trent bridge - viewing platform area. The area is being maintained by the Parish Council and, providing the land is not claimed, Willington Parish Council will be able to register their claim with the Land Registry in 3 years time i.e. 2011.
- (b) Junction of Hall Lane/Old Hall Drive – road surface breaking up.
- (c) Public toilets – confirmed that the Parish Council continue to subsidise the cost of running/cleaning the toilets. Cllrs Ford/Hood reported that SDDC are looking into various aspects of public toilets within the District, and the matter will be addressed.
- (d) Willington to Egginton crossroads, request for footway/cycle path. A parishioner asked if street lighting would also be provided if the request was granted. Cllr Ford said safety requirements would be met.

### **ACCOUNTS:**

The accounts for the Parish Council for the financial year ending 31st March 2007 have been allowed by the Audit Commission and a certificate issued.
