#### 20 Items of correspondence received for information only

- DALC Circular 23-25/2014
- Lighting on the picnic area. The lighting was put in the car park by the Council's Transport section in conjunction as part of the re-opening of Willington Station in the mid 1990's. They had capital money to improve the car park but there was no finance for their maintenance which is why they were not adopted by Street Lighting and the costs have had to be borne by Countryside. Confirmation that they will issue a PO to DCC for repair.
- DCC Ref: 885286. A job has been raised to repair the potholes on Meadow Lane but no confirmation of date.
- RURAL matters November 2014
- DCC ref BW11. An order was made by Derbyshire County Council in 2012 to upgrade Public Bridleway No 11 in Willington to a restricted byway and the Parish Council will have been consulted as part of this process. The Council made the Order based on documentary evidence that the route had been part of the public carriageway between Willington and Repton before the bridge was built and, unlike the ford itself, was not legally stopped up when the bridge opened. Objections were received to the making of the order and therefore it was submitted to the Planning Inspectorate for determination. Derbyshire County Council submitted a statement of case detailing why the order had been made and requesting that the order be confirmed. The letter from the Planning Inspectorate is confirmation that no further statements have been received in support or objection to the confirmation following consultation, the Inspector will visit the site before writing the decision letter.
