- DCC inspected Footpath 6 which runs from Kingfisher Lane to Ivy Close on 22.10.14 and advised that the footpath was in a satisfactory condition at the time of inspection.
- DCC response concerning the footpath off Kingfisher Lane. The footpath that runs from Kingfisher Lane to the rear of the properties on Saxon Grove is relatively clear from litter and detritus and doesn't require any attention at present, the footpath will receive two footway sweeps per year as part of our scheduled cleanses in Willington. The area of grassed land between the doctors surgery and the footpath appears to be part of the surgery development and would therefore fall under the surgery's responsibility to maintain. It appears that some effort has already been made to landscape the area as new tree saplings have been planted.
- Information from SDDC ref new Repton Road development and flooding. Surface water from the development is to be directed to a new balancing pond on the site, to the left of the access road/track as you look into the site. This will then discharge at no greater than greenfield rates directly to the Egginton Brook which is then joined by the Sands Brook (along Repton Road) before discharging into the Trent. Ultimately with a control on discharge from the balancing pond and it sitting upstream of the Sands Brook tributary there should be no impact and the flood modelling work undertaken in support of the application concludes this.
