Thanks a lot for your email. I understand you are concerned regarding the dog fouling in Willington area, We the community safety enforcement officers heavily rely on the information provided by the local residents about the irresponsible dog owners in their area. We have taken a number of enforcement actions against the perpetrators after we received info in the shape of a video footage, photographs or even just an email with the address of the perpetrator who are leaving the dog mess behind and we have taken actions ranging from a warning letter to a Fixed penalty notices against the perpetrators.

I suggest if you could make the local resident aware through the local Facebook pages or local news letters to report the perpetrators to us and we will take actions. We also put some posts on the SDDC website and on the Facebook page encouraging people to report us with some info about the perpetrators. We also time to time patrol the different areas however its really difficult to cover every where because its only 3 of us and to cover the whole District is a big ask. I will make sure that I the area near the school you mentioned in your email is patrolled next time I am in Willington area. If and when you come back to us with a few hotspot areas we will what other course of actions we may able to take as well. Also I have erected some dog fouling signs in the area in the past and will re enforce them on next visit to the area.
