Please see the following message which I have today sent to DCC

"Is there intention as part of any DCC maintenance programme, to surface treat any of the pavements in Willington, South Derbyshire - I refer in particular to those in St Michaels Close, which after 50 years with no maintenance and with much patchwork, have increasingly become more difficult to use for we long-term inhabitants"

I note with interest the recent excellent resurfacing of the pavement alongside the B5008 between the Derbys/Staffs County Boundary at Burton on Trent, and the Newton Park Hotel, a distance of more than a mile. Only one thing is missing - footfall.
