Afternoon

At the June Meeting of Council, it was agreed that you be asked to reconsider the siting of the Little Library. Further to your email below, we would have to re-visit this with Network Rail due to the following conditions they have already requested (the following is an excerpt from their email);

... subject to receiving and reviewing the above information I would suggest providing consent by way of a memorandum of understanding signed by both parties. Please note that any consent given would be subject to the conditions that the Library is maintained by the Parish Council at all times, that upon termination of the agreement this is removed at the PCs expense and that the PC accept full liability for the Library and Indemnify NR against any losses associated with the Library.

I understand that this appears to be overly complicated but this is due to the legal agreement that is in place between the Parish Council and Network Rail which we must adhere to.

I would be grateful if you could consider the Parish Council's request to consider siting this at the Church in order that this matter can be concluded as soon as possible.
